Can we create a clearinghouse between industry/education identifying sources of talent. An interface between recruiters and education, materials development. Create an information exchange. Talked to Kevin M., Likes to help non-profits, works on MANCEF website might be a resource to make this an easy interface. Next step to use Marty's connection and MANCEF to find input from the MEMS and Nano industry, lots of foundries in US and Canada. An outreach into North American resource. No one knew the PCC does micro/nano so we need to advertise to industry. Todd is looking for comments best way to carry this out.
- Leverage MNTeSIG Industry Board as a possible, all encompassing industry advisory for the MNT projects.... Get more bang for the buck? Could merge this into the MNT-EC center.... Is this something we could do, bring in IAB's into the MNTeSIG? Rick: Depends, some yes, some no. Jim Marti would be nice to have, but better provide a clearinghouse, a union hall type of system for provide resources, talent.... Jared: get all the industry and educators all in one space? How do we get industry people who want to be involved to come and meet with us face to face? Marti: need a budget! (MNT-EC). Todd: MANCEF meeting in DC could be a venue bring in MNTeSIG reps. 90% of COMS folks are Industry. Getting MNTeSIG to COMS should be a goal. MNTeSIG could participate in the education session, create a session in recruiting talent as well?
